

FEES

It is the responsibility of the parents (in the case of juniors) and senior players to ensure all registration fees are paid.

Fees cover the cost of submitting teams into Leagues, tournaments, All England Netball Membership, training facility hire, equipment and club awards. These costs must be covered to ensure the financial viability of the club.

The Treasurer will issue invoices for the amount due for each member of the club.

Payments are made through England Netball ENgage system, which will be linked to your Membership Number.

Each member (and parent for U18's) must create an account on the England Netball ENgage system. Go to

https://engage.englandnetball.co.uk/EnglandNetball,

and as the account needs to be linked to CD Phoenix use Find a Club then select Create Account. Follow the instructions and then inform your team manager & the Treasurer when complete.

The fees can be paid in full or by Direct Debit of 6 monthly installments.

<u>AVAILABILITY</u>

The Club's expectation is that you as a player have committed to play the whole season for the Club.

We understand that sickness, injury and some absences are unavoidable during the season.

It is your responsibility to keep your Coach/Team Manager informed about your availability. This applies to training and matches.

Where a known absence will occur, please advise your Coach/Team Manager as early as possible in the season.

Where sickness strikes please advise your Coach/Team Manager as soon as possible, as coaching plans may need to change due to your absence.

Where an injury has occurred please keep your Coach/Team Manager up to date with how long you may be out of the game and how your recovery is progressing.

Your Coach/Team Manager may ask for a clearance from a medical practitioner before you can recommence training/playing.



TRAINING

The main training sessions are on Thursdays. Most teams train every Thursday evening outside throughout the summer months and indoors throughout the winter.

From the beginning of October to the end of March, training sessions are based indoors at East Grinstead Sports Club, Imberhorne School, Lingfield Notre Dame School and Sackville School.

During the summer months and the early part of autumn, training takes place outside at the Netball Centre based at East Grinstead Sports Club, Saint Hill Road, East Grinstead.

Training session times vary according to player age:

U10's - normally starting at 18:00 moving to 17:00 in the winter months when we go inside.

U11 - Under 15 usually commencing at 18:00.

Older age groups - typically start training at 19:30.

Junior Players: The club has a duty of care for the safety of our members. It is required that no player leaves the venue without adult supervision.

Parents, please ensure your child is picked up on time. Players will be required to stay with their Coach/Team Manager until you arrive.
